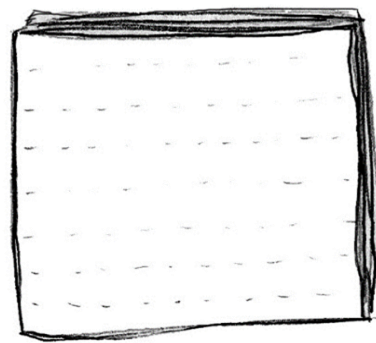


Step one: Stack 6 to 8 sheets of tissue paper, making sure edges are together.



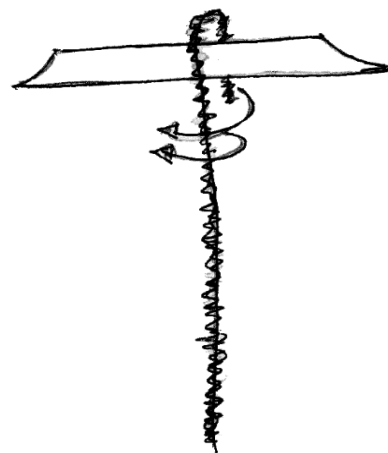
Step two: Beginning on one side, fold all layers together back and forth like a fan. Fold them about 1/2 to 3/4 inch for each section.



Step three: Holding the fanned papers together, cut corners through all thicknesses to desired shape. A curve outwards will make your petals rounded while a straight line will give you sharper-shaped petals.



Step four: Take one of the fuzzy sticks and loop it around the center of the folded paper. Twist it together below the paper as close as you can to the tissue paper.



Step five: Spread each half of flower out like a fan. Carefully pull the top layer of tissue paper up and toward the center. Continue with each layer until all layers have been pulled up. Arrange petals as desired.
